

2022 END OF SEASON SURVEY UPDATE

- Additional support for first time coordinators.
- Mentoring program to match more experienced coordinators with less experienced coordinators.
- School engagement program to increase participation from smaller primary schools and government schools.
- Increased opportunity for athletes to train and compete prior to the Interschools events.
- Promotion of one communication platform that can be used during the competitions to provide urgent and timely updates.

SNOWID RENEWAL -INTERSCHOOLS UPDATE

- All SnowID memberships will need to be renewed again in 2023. Last year / parents / families renewed their memberships ahead of the close of entries.
- The process will be the same as it was for 2022.
- All Snowracer members (Free membership category) will be sent a renewal email. They will need to follow the link and update.
- Generally, this goes to parents and does not go to schools.
- This will be possible from the middle of May.

- Teachers will need all students / families to renew before they can add entries to the Interschools on-line entry system.
- Emails from Snow Australia will support this initiative however schools will also need to encourage this in advance of the close of entries.



SNOWID RENEWAL

- All new competitors will need to register for a free Snowracer membership prior to being entered in the Interschools events.
- New SnowID / Snowracer registrations can be completed via the Snowracer website. <u>https://www.snow.org.au/membership/</u>
- SnowID's will be able to be renewed from the middle of May.

Known System issues when uploading entries:

- If SnowID's have not been activated for 2023 then excel spreadsheets will not be able to be uploaded.
- Some children have multiple SnowID's they may reactivate a different one tot h one the school uses.
- Instead of reactivating the parent sets up a new one and does not inform the school of the new number.






INTERSCHOOLS ONLINE OFFICIAL'S COURSE


All School Coordinators are asked to highly recommend subscription to the Vic Interschools Enews by their entire Snowsports community.

All families must be subscribed to the Enews so that they receive the alerts to check the start lists prior to the event entry closure dates. NO LATE ENTRIES OR CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- The conduct of competitors and spectators at event sites in recent years has been generally very positive
- Some serious incidents have taken place around the village over recent years
- It is recommended that the Code of Conduct be presented to parents and children at bib presentations and information nights
- Non field of play changes to the Code of Conduct to be published
- Representation of the school on and off the snow throughout the event week

VOLUNTEERS

- Schools are required to provide 1 volunteer for every 11 Ski Cross and Mogul event entries, 8
 Alpine GS entries and every 6 Snowboard event entries. Fewer entries than those listed above will
 not require a school to provide volunteers.
- Once you have entered your event entries the system will notify you of your volunteer requirements
- You can allocate your volunteers to the preferred events as soon as your entries are in the system
- Gives plenty of time for volunteers to plan for specific days of the event week
- Volunteers if they are not season pass holders will be provided with a FOC day lift ticket from the event office in Alpine Central the day prior to, or morning of the event
- Volunteers must present themselves to the chief of course in the start area 15 minutes prior to inspection or training
- Schools may be fined or sanctioned for absent volunteers
- Refer to the Officials online training course on the website





Race Suits

'Race suits are <u>not</u> permitted in Division 4, 5 & 6 events. Race suits are permitted in Divisions 1, 2 & 3 Alpine GS and Snowboard GS events.' Implemented at Regional, State and National event level.

Waxing - in all Disciplines

'Waxing of any type is prohibited in the start area or competition course arena. Fluoro wax and Fluorocarbon liquid sprays are prohibited. The Interschools Committee advises that equipment may be subject to inspection.' Implemented at Regional, State and National event level.

Complete Stop – in Alpine and Snowboard GS + Ski Cross and Snowboard Cross

'If a competitor comes to a complete stop (e.g., after a fall) they must no longer continue. A complete stop is deemed to occur when the competitor is no longer moving downhill. The competitor must exit to the side of the course as soon as possible to avoid interfering with the next competitor's run. The competitor is <u>not</u> permitted to hike or hop uphill toward a missed gate. Provided that the competitor does not cross the finish line, they will record a DNF (Did Not Finish) for that run. In the event that the said competitor DOES cross the finish line, they may be disqualified (DSQ) for continuing. A competitor must not be physically assisted during their run, unless for safety reasons. They will record a DSQ (Disqualification) for that run if they are assisted.' Implemented at Regional, State and National event level.



Loss of both skis – in Alpine GS and Ski Cross.

NOTE that the intent of this rule will also be adopted in Snowboard GS and Snowboard Cross events. 'If a competitor loses both skis, they must exit the course as soon as possible. Provided that the competitor does not cross the finish line, they will record a DNF (Did Not Finish) for this run. In the event that the said competitor DOES cross the finish line, they may be disqualified for continuing.

Exception: In the event that a competitor loses both skis after the last gate they may cross the finish line without skis.' Implemented at Regional, State and National event level.

Loss of one ski - in Alpine GS and Ski Cross.

NOTE that the intent of this rule will also be adopted in Snowboard GS and Snowboard Cross events. If a competitor loses one ski, they must exit the course as soon as possible. Provided that the competitor does not cross the finish line, they will record a DNF (Did Not Finish) for this run. In the event that the said competitor DOES cross the finish line, they may be disqualified for continuing.

<u>Exception</u>: In the event that a competitor loses one ski without having committed a gate fault or without coming to a complete stop, they may continue as long as there are <u>no more than</u> two gates to complete on one ski before the finish. NOTE: BOTH ski boots must pass ALL gates correctly. Provided that a ski is connected to a ski boot, it must pass the gate-line correctly at all times." Implemented at Regional, State and National event level.

MULTICLASS

The 2023 Victorian Interschools Snowsports Championships will include the Victorian Interschools Multiclass Event, to be held on **Wednesday 23rd August**.

This event, which is organised by the Multiclass Sports Association, in conjunction with the Victorian Interschools, Disabled Wintersport Australia (DWA) and Special Olympics Victoria; provides young people, with a physical or intellectual impairment, with the opportunity to compete at Victorian Interschools in their own event.


